



Dear Parents

Due to the recent number of complaints from residents of roads near to the school, about careless or inconsiderate parking, the Police and school are going to try and work together to see if the situation can be improved.

Residents have been tasked by the Police to take photographs of cars that are illegally or inconsiderately parked. The photographs will then be sent to the Police for a decision to be made on the most appropriate course of action to take. This could be advice to the driver or it could be a ticket for any offences or for repeat offenders.

Please do not challenge the residents about what they are doing if you see them taking photographs of cars and if you are aggressive or abusive, they have also been advised to photograph the people and they will also be dealt with for any public order offences that are committed so please be respectful at all times.

Just to clarify the situation regarding parking;

A continuous single yellow line means "No waiting" in the time zone displayed on the plates. In the case of Hanmore Rd, this is between 0830 and 0930 and 1445 to 1545 Monday to Friday.

The single yellow lines are at the junctions of roads and are there to give people a clear line of vision along the road to make it safe to pull out of the junction. If you park on a yellow line, you obscure this view and create a hazard for other road users. The fixed penalty for this offence is currently a £30 fine.

If you obstruct someone's driveway then you could also face a similar fine.

The residents accept that school drop off and pick up times will be busy but have been faced with some hostile responses from drivers when they have tried to speak to them in the past.

In addition to the Police action, the school will be publishing photographs in their correspondence of vehicles that have been parked inconsiderately.
