- A cutting collection – if there are any plants in your garden that can be grown from cuttings. Please send a named specimen in after the holiday.

Please find enclosed your child's personal sunflower seed and the seeds that have been allocated to your year group. To grow them all you will need to do is find a flowerpot or plastic cup. Fill the cup with soil or compost and keep it moist. Then place the container on a bright windowsill.

Please bring the crop seedlings and cuttings into school the first week back after the holidays. Plant the Sunflower in your garden and keep us informed of its growing progress; you could send in photographs of its progress for us to share on our school Facebook site.

To qualify for the final of the Sunflower competition your child will need to bring in a photograph of themselves, the sunflower and a measurement for scrutiny by the judging panel. This will be in September. However, Year Six children are still welcome to enter and email us the evidence!
