Internet connections available to children are filtered to minimize the chances of access to inappropriate materials and children's use of IT is supervised. All pupils learn about e-safety as part of their computing lessons.

We would encourage parents to supervise their children's internet access at home. Parents are reminded that it is inappropriate for children under 13 to have their own Facebook or other social media accounts (or unsupervised access to shared accounts).
