

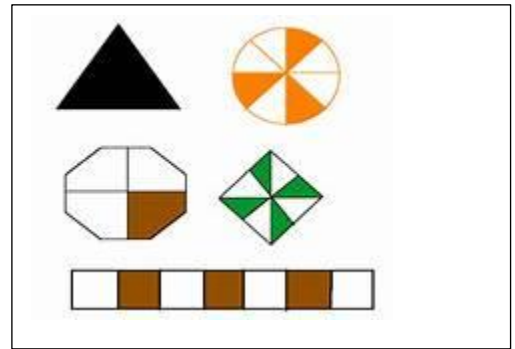
Welcome to Year 3

We also solved problems by using fractions and moving shapes. We had to use vocabulary to master fractions.



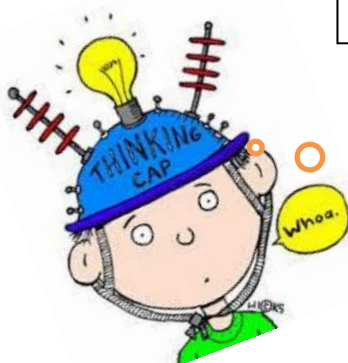
