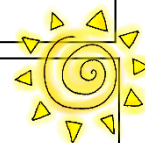

Main topics and learning this term:

Graffiti and Cave Art

The Digestive System



Our main topic this term is Stone Age to Iron Age.

The children will be working towards explaining the changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age. They will be learning about features of Stone and Iron Age life such as tools, burials, art, shelters and settlements.

Our Science topic this half term is The Digestive System. Within this unit we will be learning about different parts of the digestive system, including our teeth. We will also be thinking about healthy eating.

We will be encouraging lots of creativity through our Art topic of Graffiti and Cave Art. The children will be learning about the origins of cave art and will hopefully be having a go at creating some of their own.
